



NATIONAL YOUTH LEADER TRAINING (NYLT) 2010

INSTRUCTIONS FOR REGISTRATIONS

1. Each Troop may register as many Scouts as they desire. Registration is limited and based on a first-come, first-served basis.
2. Both the fee schedule and payment timelines have been changed. To get the discounts, Scouts must be paid in full by the discount dates.
 - \$205.00 For Second week of Camp*
 - \$220.00 Snowbird by March 14, 2010 (Ice Cream Social date)*
 - \$240.00 Early Bird by May 15, 2010*
 - \$260.00 Regular*
 - \$280.00 at the door (June 13, 2010)*
3. Fill out the T-Shirt area of the registration form and add any additional fees for extra t-shirts to the camp fee above.
4. Prepare and attach a check for each registration (include fees for camp and shirts). Checks are payable to the Boy Scouts of America.
5. Complete the attached registration form(s). (One form for each participant)
 - a) Scouts' names
 - b) Scouts' Date of Birth. **Scouts must be 13 and 1/2 years old as of June 1, 2010. No one over the age of 18 is allowed to attend NYLT.**
 - c) Scouts' current rank
 - d) Make sure all information is filled out thoroughly, including phone number and email address (please print clearly)
6. Complete a Participant Code of Conduct form and submit that with the permission form. All parent and scout leader signatures are required!
7. Return all forms and fees to the Scout Office (or the Ice Cream Social)
 - a. All fees received will be deposited by the Council Office.
 - b. Checks should be made payable to the Potawatomi Area Council or B.S.A.**REFUNDS WILL BE BASED UPON THE CAMP LONG LAKE REFUND POLICIES.**
8. Follow up with your Scouts: Make sure the enrollment package and physical form are returned to the Council Registrar's office prior to June 1, 2010.
9. Assist the Scout in accumulating the supplies listed on the attached page. **MAKE SURE TO BUY UNIFORM PIECES EARLY!** The Scout Shop might need to order sizes for you and that takes time!
10. Each scout needs to have a pre-course assessment completed. We will have plenty of people to help complete these assessments at the Ice Cream Social on March 14, 2010. If you cannot attend the Ice Cream Social, we will provide you with information on how this can be completed.
11. Help the Scout arrive on time at Camp Long Lake on June 13, 2010. (3/10 rev.)
