Local Council Jamboree Information Sheet

- Dates** Leaving Thursday morning, July 22, 2010.
Returning Thursday, August 5, 2010.
- Travel Plans** The Potawatomi Area Council jamboree contingent will leave on Thursday, July 22, 2010, at 10:00 a.m., and take coach buses to Washington, D.C.
- While in Washington, D.C., ample time will be allowed to tour historical and governmental sites. We will camp at the jamboree until the morning of August 4, 2010, returning to Waukesha on August 5, 2010.
- Organization** The jamboree is open to all who are qualified on a first-come basis. After our troops have been filled, a stand-by list of alternates will be established. Scouts will be assigned to a jamboree troop consisting of 36 Scouts and four adult leaders. You will be a member of a patrol within the troop. The council contingent will consist of 2 troops.
- Total Costs**** \$2,085 for Scouts plus \$10 application fee [through National].
\$1,000 for leaders plus \$10 application fee [through National].

Fee Includes **The jamboree fee covers all transportation, tours, admission fees, meals, lodging, and patrol and troop equipment, as well as insurance. Your fee also covers the training camp before the jamboree. The only additional expense will be your personal equipment, uniforms, and spending money. **The fee is based on bus fare of \$27,000. If this should be increased, we may have to increase the total jamboree fee accordingly.**

Refund Policy If you sign up for the jamboree and then find that you cannot attend, you will receive a full refund from the Potawatomi Area Council only if there is an alternate to take your place.

In the event there is not an alternate, a partial refund will be made. This includes the fees you have paid to date, less any expenses related to contractual agreements made on your behalf.

All requests for a refund must be in writing with full explanation of reason(s).
