- Tent
- Sleeping bag & sleeping pad (or cot)
- Camp chair
- Sleeping attire
 - While it is April, it might be cold at night, we recommend a stocking hat and socks to sleep in
- Change of clothes
- Personal toiletries as required for a campout
- Sturdy shoes
- Notebook, pen, pencil for note-taking
- Weather-appropriate outdoor clothing (jacket, rain jacket, hat, gloves, etc.)
- Water bottle
- Completed Medical Form Parts A & B (turned in at registration)
