There will be two patrol divisions: **Leadership Patrols** - a patrol with two or more Scouts of Star rank or above; **Natural Patrols** - Boy Scouts through First Class. A patrol must consist of at least five boys. There will be several problems with 15 minutes working time for each problem. Both patrol divisions will receive the same problems, with awards for the top three patrols in both divisions.
