Re: Vigil Honor and Founders Award nominations

Fellow Arrowman,

It is time again to select lodge members to be recognized for the Vigil Honor and Founders Award. Youth on the Vigil Selection Committee need your assistance to select qualified Arrowmen.

The Vigil Honor - is a high mark of distinction and recognition reserved for those Arrowmen who, by reason of exceptional service, personal effort, and unselfish interest, have made distinguished contributions **beyond** the immediate responsibilities of their position or office to **one or more** of the following: their lodge, the Order of the Arrow, Scouting or their Scout camp.

On the second page of this letter are the candidates who meet the eligibility requirement of being a **Brotherhood member for at least two years**. In order to be fully eligible, candidates must be sure to **pay Lodge dues for the 2010 calendar year**. Write a nomination explaining why the nominee deserves the Vigil Honor according to the standards mentioned above. Youth on the Selection Committee may not know the nominee so well written, detailed letters improve their chances. Include details on organizations/committees, positions held, time involved, etc. Suggest one or more respectful American Indian names based on the candidate's qualities, talents and traits. Examples are found in the Lenni-Lenape Word List at the back of the OA Handbook.

The Founder's Award - was created to honor and recognize those Arrowmen who have given outstanding service to their **lodge**. The award is reserved for an Arrowmen who demonstrates to fellow Arrowmen that he or she memorializes in his or her everyday life the spirit of achievement as described by founder E. Urner Goodman and cofounder Carroll A. Edson.

Youth and adults can be nominated for the award. Write a detailed nomination describing the nominee's service to the Wag-O-Shag Lodge and why they deserve the Founder's award. What positions has the person held and for how long? Are they active in chapters or on lodge committees? If an adult, how have they served the youth? The more information you include, the better our youth will be able to evaluate the candidate.
