- ☐ Pack(s) to put equipment in



- ☐ 10' long by ¼" diameter rope per patrol member



- ☐ First Aid equipment



- ☐ Four (4) 6 foot long staves, also used for lashing



- ☐ Stretcher blanket



- ☐ Splint



- ☐ Kindling



- ☐ Compass



- ☐ Back packing stove



- ☐ Fire starter/matches



- ☐ Additional blanket or sleeping bag



- ☐ Tinder



- ☐ Logs less than 2" diameter



- ☐ Bow saw



- ☐ Pocket knife



- ☐ Scout Manual



- ☐ Cooking pot



- ☐ Spoon, cup, and bowl (per participant)



- ☐ Tarp at least 8' x 8'

DUTCH OVEN LUNCH

Dutch ovens will be collected at registration and labeled with your Troop number. Troops with larger groups may request a second Dutch oven.

Your meal will be cooked while Scouts participate in events so it is ready for lunch. Please bring pre-assembled Dutch oven meals that primarily require cooking or reheating rather than recipes with multiple preparation steps. You may add any finishing touches when you arrive, such as thickening a stew or adding cheese to a recipe.

EXAMPLES

- **Mexican Lasagna** – Pre-assembled and ready to cook
- **Beef Stew** – Beef, vegetables, potatoes, beef stock, and seasonings
- **Hamburger Hash** – Made with pre-cooked ground beef
- **Chili**

IMPORTANT NOTES

- Turn in Nuggets after the last event, then take place in Sled Judging and the Sled Race while final awards are calculated.
- Scouts will need to practice good time management to get through all of the events.
- Please dress for cold weather - you will be outdoors all day.
- Limited indoor lunch area. Clubhouse will be open for warming up if needed.
- All troops are welcome to attend.
